Guidelines for best results:

Bleed Zone:

this area is necessary for graphics to be cut without white margins

Crop Line:


this line is the physical boundary and where the cutting of the label will take place

Safe Area:

area where you can put the writing and everything that should not be cut

- Work this file as is and keep it in CMYK Fogra 39, best if edited in Adobe Illustrator®, Corel Draw®, Affinity Designer®, Inkscape or similar apps.
- Same settings apply for bitmaps as well(or raster or photos) you may want to place in the layout, all imported pictures should be priorly converted to CMYK Fogra 39 working space, 300dpi is a plus.
- CMYK is used for best printing results but sRGB should work as well.
- Text should be at least 3mm high for better reading.
